Lawyers uphold the law of the country and protect their client's legal rights. A career in law can be rewarding, in terms of earning potential and job satisfaction. Learning about the duties of a lawyer and how to become one can help you determine if it is a good career path for you. In this article, we discuss how to become a lawyer, what these professionals do and answer some frequently asked questions about this profession.

What Does A Lawyer Do?

Lawyers use their knowledge of the law to help clients understand and navigate legal matters. While their roles and responsibilities may vary depending on their area of expertise, most lawyers perform the following duties:

Preparing legal documents and filing them with the appropriate courts/authorities Attending trials and hearings with clients

Collaborating with police and investigators and building cases for trials and mediations Reviewing a case and suggesting legal options for clients

Presenting arguments in favour of a client in front of the judge

Qualifications For Lawyers

To start your career as a lawyer, you require to first complete a degree course in law from a recognised university. There are a wide variety of courses that can help you in your pursuit, such as:

Combined LL.B

You can pursue a combined law degree that concentrates the duration of two degrees into five years, which would otherwise usually take six years. The popular combined Bachelor of Laws (LL.B) degrees are:

BA LL.B B.Com LL.B BBA LL.B Bachelor of Laws (LL.B) The traditional law degree is essentially a post-graduate course that can be pursued by a student who already has an undergraduate degree in arts, commerce or science. This is a three-year course that follows the first undergraduate degree.

Master of Laws (LL.M)

A master's degree in law, also known as an LL.M, can be pursued only after securing a Bachelor of Laws. It is usually either a two-year or a one-year course.

While basic lawyer requirements can be fulfilled by pursuing an LL.B course, many lawyers choose to go for masters to help hone their skills further and enjoy better career prospects.

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How To Become A Lawyer?

To know how to become a lawyer, its important to be aware that lawyers require to meet the minimum educational requirements and pass certain industry exams to practice law. Here are the basic steps to become a lawyer:

1. Complete your higher secondary education

You require to at least complete your higher secondary education (10+2) from a recognised school education board to pursue a bachelor's degree in law. Students of any stream, including science, arts and commerce are eligible to enroll in a bachelor's programme. If you choose to pursue the law degree after your 10+2, you require to enroll in a five-year integrated Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) course, such as BA LL.B, B.Com LL.B or BBA LL.B. Some universities even offer a five-year integrated honours programme, such as BA LL.B. (Hons.) These programmes allow you to choose a law specialisation.

2. Complete your graduation in any stream

Another route to pursue a law degree is through a three-year LL.B. course after your graduation. If you choose to take that route, you first require to earn a bachelor's degree in any stream. Whether you have a Bachelor of Arts (BA), Bachelor of Science (BSc), Bachelor of Commerce (BCom) or Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA), you can apply for the three-year LL.B programme.

3. Take a law entrance exam

Most law schools select candidates based on their results in a law entrance exam. One of the most popular national level entrance exams is the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT). It is a two-hour long exam that usually comprises 150 multiple-choice questions, with one mark for each correct answer and a deduction of 0.25 marks for each incorrect answer. Candidates require to score at least 50% marks in the CLAT to be eligible for admission. The CLAT scores are accepted by most law colleges.

Apply to law school Once you have received your law entrance test scores, you can begin applying to law schools. Most students apply to several law schools so they have a few options to choose from. For each application you send, you require to submit official transcripts, law entrance test scores, letters of recommendation and additional information.

Many schools seek candidates with high CLAT scores, excellent letters of recommendation and extracurricular activities. Completing an internship at your local courthouse or law firm can show your interest in the field. Volunteering with a group in your community can demonstrate your eagerness to learn.

5. Complete your bachelor's degree in law

During your undergraduate degree in law, you study subjects like political science, sociology and economics. These subjects help you understand more about the society within which you would practice law. Along with these subjects, you also require to study law subjects such as constitutional law, criminal law and family law. You require to pass all the subjects in your final year to become a law graduate.

According to the government guidelines, law graduates are required to clear the All India Bar Examination (AIBE) to be eligible to practice as a lawyer in India. The Bar Council of India conducts this exam once every year, and prior registration is mandatory for all aspirants. To be eligible to appear for the All India Bar Examination, you are required to enroll as an advocate with a State Bar Council. But, this requirement is only applicable to students who have graduated in the academic year of 2009-10 or later. If you have passed your law degree before that, then this exam is not mandatory for you.

Once you have cleared the AIBE, you have the licence to practice law as a profession. The next ideal step would be to either seek out a legal job with a legal firm as an associate advocate or start practicing law independently. Corporate law Finance law

MSc in Law and Finance -oxford university

About the course

The MSc in Law and Finance (MLF) is taught jointly by the Law Faculty and the Saïd Business School. It will provide you with an advanced interdisciplinary understanding of economic and financial concepts and their application to legal topics. The MSc combines a highly analytic academic core with tailor-made practical applications derived from collaboration with professional and regulatory organisations.

Course structure

Students studying the MLF take three core courses and then choose either to take the law or finance stream.

There are also pre-sessional courses in maths and financial reporting.

Core courses

There are two core finance courses (Finance and First Principles of Financial Economics), and a core interdisciplinary course (Law and Economics of Corporate Transactions). Finance is taught during the first and second terms. First Principles of Financial Economics is taught during the first term and Law and Economics of Corporate Transactions is taught during the second and third terms.

Law stream

In addition to the core MLF courses, students selecting the Law Stream will take two law electives from a tailored list of about 10 law courses that are available to students on the Bachelor of Civil Law (BCL). Students may choose to select two half options in law in place of a law elective, thereby allowing students to study a wider range of subjects. The list of law electives comprises courses that are business law-oriented and thus are intended to complement both each other and the MLF course as a whole. In taking these electives, you will be joined by students taking the Law Faculty's other taught graduate courses, the BCL and the Magister Juris (MJur). Teaching may be delivered over the duration of the academic year using a range of different formats, including lectures, seminars and tutorials. Outside of the seminars and tutorials you will be expected to read extensively in order to acquire the necessary knowledge to engage with course material at an appropriate level.

Finance stream

Currently, as an alternative to taking two law electives, MLF students can select the Finance Stream, which is taught by interactive classes at the Saïd Business School during the second and third terms. By selecting the Finance Stream, you will take only one law elective. In lieu of the second law elective, you will take a mandatory finance course, Corporate Valuation, in the second term and one finance elective in the third term. The menu of finance electives has been selected from those offered by the Saïd Business School for the <u>Master of Business Administration (MBA)</u> and <u>MSc in Financial Economics (MFE)</u>, comprising finance courses intended to complement the MLF programme. The electives are studied at the Saïd Business School alongside MBA and MFE students. It is anticipated that the Finance Stream will be available in future years, subject to notice.

Supervision

The allocation of graduate supervision for this course is the responsibility of the Law Faculty and/or the Saïd Business School and it is not always possible to accommodate the preferences of incoming graduate students to work with a particular member of staff. Under exceptional circumstances a supervisor may be found outside the Law Faculty and/or the Saïd Business School.

Assessment

MLF students undertake assessment and/or examinations in each of the three terms of the programme. The core courses of Finance, Law and Economics of Corporate Transactions and First Principles of Financial Economics use a range of assessment methods which may include group work exercises, timed examinations and formal coursework.

Most law elective subjects are assessed by means of timed examinations at the end of the course but some subjects use assessed essays written over a longer period. Further information about forms of assessment is provided on the <u>Law Faculty Admissions page</u>. Those taking the dissertation option are required to submit a dissertation in the third term. Finance Stream elective subjects are assessed by formal coursework and/or practical work and/or a timed examination during the third term. The mandatory Finance Stream course, Corporate Valuation, is assessed during the second term.

Graduate destinations

Typically, over half of each class of MLF graduates go on to employment within the legal sector in London or internationally, usually at large, corporate law firms, at training contract or associate level, as well as in a variety of in-house roles. Others go on to work in fields such as investment banking, private equity, consulting and policymaking. Each year, a small number of students also embark on a career in academia.

As an MLF student, you will have access to the University Careers Services as well as to some relevant support from the Saïd Business School's Careers Service, and to dedicated MLF careers support as you consider your career strategy and move into the application and interview processes.

Additional speaker events are run to complement the MLF programme, which facilitate contact with senior practitioners of law and finance, and MLF students will be a member of both the SBS and wider University alumni networks.

Changes to this course and your supervision

The University will seek to deliver this course in accordance with the description set out in this course page. In this article, we profile the top 30 most affordable online master's in finance degree programs.

Financial analysts provide guidance to businesses and organizations. Investment decisions, portfolio assessment, and other types of assistance require the help of a financial expert. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics and the Occupational Outlook Handbook, the job outlook for financial analysts is projected to grow 11 percent through the year 2026. Due to the anticipated growth, colleges and universities are offering master's in finance and online master's in finance degree programs.

We reviewed 63 colleges and universities with online master's in finance programs, or closely related degrees. We confirmed accreditation, either regional or national, to help narrow our search. We collected graduate tuition/fees from the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) College Navigator and selected programs that cost under \$20,000/year. We also looked at rankings from major publications like U.S. News and World Report to see if the program or institution had received recognition. The colleges and universities on our list are ranked in order of raw affordability.

Below is our list of the top 30 most affordable online master's in finance degree programs.

#30 – Southern New Hampshire University

completely online allowing for maximum flexibility. Courses include corporate financial management, cost accounting, financial modeling, and graduate finance capstone. Southern New Hampshire University is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. The MS in Finance program is accredited by the NEASC and ACBSP. U.S. News ranks Southern New Hampshire #86 in regional universities North and #1 in most innovative schools North.

We narrowed our original pool of schools by applying the following criteria: national or regional accreditation, institution rankings with at least one reputable publication like U.S. News and World Report, and affordable graduate tuition and fees less than \$34,000 per year. We then ranked our findings according to raw affordability.





Many programs offer specialty tracks or concentrations allowing the MBA student to not only complete the foundational coursework, but to choose a specific area of expertise such as information technology, logistics, marketing, sales, and more. These specialty concentrations are attractive to potential employers and allow students to choose a field that aligns well with their interests within a specific career trajectory.

Some of the top jobs for those with an online MBA include IT manager, financial manager, data analyst, HR manager, and management analyst. These occupations are expected to experience above-average demand due to the specific skills and knowledge these graduates possess. In addition, the pay for these occupations is typically well into the six-figure range, putting the employee into the upper echelon of earnings.

What is the job outlook for individuals with an affordable MBA online degree?

Obtaining a master's in business administration is a vital component for individuals seeking management positions in many industries and career paths. An affordable online MBA gives professionals the chance to learn broad-based skills and knowledge that can be applied to many different contexts. From accounting, finance, and supply chain management to data-driven decision making, students learn applied skills that make them attractive candidates for management positions. Moreover, many management positions now require a master's degree, compared to years past where a bachelor's degree and experience would suffice. As such is the case, an MBA is more important than ever.

All online MBA degrees are not created equal. Some programs offer a generalist MBA, while others embed specializations students can choose from. Those focusing on a specific specialization tend to do better in the job market because of their specialized skill sets. Common specializations include finance, accounting, project management, information technology management, and healthcare management. It is critical for the MBA candidate to select a program with a specialization that fits their career trajectory and interests.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), management positions are expected to experience above average growth of 8% through 2026. This is double the average growth for all other occupations tracked by the BLS. The data confirms an affordable online MBA is still a worthwhile investment.

How much money can you earn with an MBA online degree?

Postsecondary education has historically been the most effective method of improving socioeconomic status. More education and training in an individual will typically equate to more earning power and social mobility. According to the National Association of Colleges and Employers, the average starting salary for 2020 MBA graduates is expected to be \$79,043, more than \$20,000 more than those who graduate with a bachelor's degree in business. Moreover, the \$79,043 salary far

outpaces the average salary for all occupations, which is just over \$39,000, according to the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics.

A recent survey of MBA graduates stated the importance of contemplating and crystalizing career goals. This allows the MBA candidate to have a specific career path and to follow that path with determination and conviction, which improves job prospects.

As with other occupations, industry plays a major role in compensation. Data obtained from U.S. News and World Report shows the highest paying industries for MBA graduates includes consulting (\$140,187), financial services (\$130,001), technology (\$120,784), retail (\$115,370), and real estate (\$112,086).

An online MBA has always been a sound investment – with a handsome return on investment. The newest data indicate that the trend should continue for the foreseeable future.

What are the admission requirements for affordable MBA online programs?

Admission requirements for affordable online MBA programs do vary, but there are multiple admission requirements and components that are common across most programs.

The vast majority of online MBA programs require foundational knowledge and skills in core business functions such as accounting, economics, finance, management, and mathematics. Most programs either require undergraduate coursework to show mastery or a bachelor's degree in a business-related major. Students with nonbusiness bachelor degrees typically enroll in approved undergraduate courses at a four-year institution or community college upon approval. These courses generally consist of a year of basic accounting classes, micro/macroeconomics, finance, statistics, business calculus, management, and marketing.

Students applying to top business programs will need to take either the GMAT or GRE. These tests are common requirements among graduate business programs. Top schools are competitive and require strong scores, typically at or above the 75th percentile. There are also a number of business programs that require standardized testing that require test scores between the 30th and 50th percentile. For those wishing to forego standardized testing, there are several programs that do not require it for admission. Other common admission application requirements include transcripts, 2-3 letters of recommendation, a personal statement, and a writing sample.

What classes do you take while earning an MBA online degree?

While curriculum varies between programs, most online MBA programs focus on developing core business competencies, along with strong leadership and management practices. Because the degree prepares graduates for management-level, and even executive-level careers, a strong foundation in common business functions and management are a must.

Core curriculum classes focusing on applied skill-building tend to center on accounting, marketing, finance, data analysis in decision making, and supply chain/logistics. Courses come with a variety of different names, but these concepts are generally universal.

Aside from core business classes, MBA candidates will take a number of courses to help them develop competencies in leadership, decision-making, strategic planning, and management. These courses are critical to the MBA graduate, who will be tasked with leading teams and organizations during their career. In recent years, these courses have taken on more of an analytical approach that requires students to be able to make decisions based on strong data analysis. As such, courses in statistics and computer science are becoming more common.

Aside from core business and management classes, the remaining coursework tends to focus on elective classes related to a specialization or concentration chosen by the student. These courses are career- and industry-specific and drill down into the key skills and concepts within the chosen field.

MPA degrees carry moderate to high earnings potential, but salary depends on job location, level of experience, and career sector. With an online master's in public administration, students gain knowledge and a skill set necessary for work as an administrator in government, nonprofit, and private organizations. The online format of an MPA program is ideally designed for individuals with outside obligations, such as work and family.

Top Accelerated Online MPA Programs Methodology

We reviewed over 150 colleges and universities listed by the Center for Educational Statistics (NCES) College Navigator and reputable online sources that offered online MPA programs. We narrowed our original pool of schools by applying the following criteria: accelerated program offerings (online MPA programs taking less than two years to complete or fast-track courses that run less than 16 weeks in length), accreditation (regional and/or national), and institution and/or program rankings with at least one major publication like U.S. News and World Report. We then listed the MPA programs according to raw affordability.

Below are the resulting selections for our top accelerated online MPA programs of 2021.





Frequently Asked Questions What jobs can you get with an accelerated online MPA degree?

An accelerated online MPA degree opens doors to various occupations that pay moderate to high wages. Similar to an MBA, a master's in public administration teaches business and leadership skills within the context of a government or nonprofit agency. Many MPA graduates move on to positions at all levels of government (local, regional, state, federal) with the hopes of moving into administration. Similarly, MPA graduates often move on to manage non-profit organizations as well as managing firms that regularly deal with government personnel. Common careers include city planners, city managers, policy analysts, government program coordinators, and statisticians. Because the government is so vast, MPA graduates may work in several employment sectors, including criminal justice, education, health care, homeland security, and much more. Working at the federal level analyzing and developing public policy is also a common career path. Many online MPA programs offer specializations within their programs designed to give students the skills and knowledge in a specific area. Because MPA curriculum develops skills in accounting, economics, finance, policy, public relations, and leadership, graduates are well equipped to move into public service positions with great upward mobility. MPA graduates with internship experience often have better employment outcomes upon graduation.

What is the job outlook for individuals with an accelerated online MPA degree?

The job outlook for individuals with an accelerated online MPA degree vary by industry. The average growth rate for all occupations tracked by the Bureau of Labor Statistics through 2028 is expected to be 5% with some industries such as health care and information technology expected to be in the double digits.

MPA graduates often move into occupations with the federal government, which employs over 2 million people who carry out critical government functions such as food safety, emergency services, and scientific research. In total, there are over 350 federal government occupations. According to the United States Department of Labor, the average federal employee earns a salary of \$85,000.

While the growth rate for federal government jobs is expected to be marginal, one of the main benefits is job security. The federal government is far less likely to lay off employees compared to private sector employees. MPA graduates with the option to move to high-employment areas should have outstanding job opportunities. Approximately 22% of federal employment is concentrated in Maryland, Virginia, and Washington, DC – home to many federal agencies. In addition, 15% of federal workers reside in California and Texas. Other states with an above-average number of federal jobs include Florida, Georgia, and Pennsylvania.

Are there professional associations students can join while enrolled in an accelerated online MPA program?

American Society for Public Administration – the ASPA offers a student discount through its website and is one of the leading organizations for public service professionals. The association provides professional development, networking, and research opportunities, and more through its membership services. In addition, students and new professionals have access to services specifically for them through the Founders' Fellows program, which supports new professionals through conference attendance and research opportunities and presentations. The Student and New Professional Summit, which takes place during the ASPA annual conference, also serves as a support and networking system for students and new hires.

Association for Public Policy Analysis and Management – The Association for Public Policy Analysis and Management was founded in May 1979 at a conference at Duke University, through the cooperation of 15 institutions. Since that time, the association

has evolved into a comprehensive group of individuals and institutions that foster policy analysis and research, networking opportunities, career support, and one of the most respected journals in the industry – The Journal of Policy Analysis and Management, which published its first issue in 1981. After years of being headquartered at Duke University, the association is now housed in Washington, DC and governed by a full-time executive director and staff.

How long does it take to earn an accelerated online MPA degree?

As with other accelerated online master's degrees, the timeline to complete varies but is typically in the 12-18 month range. It should be noted that most students complete a program in 2-3 years due to outside demands such as work and family. Most programs require 36 credits to complete, which equates to 12 courses. It is important any potential candidate understand the program's structure before applying as they vary greatly when it comes to course loads. Students who want to finish in 12-18 are required to attend full-time, which means taking at least six credits (two classes) per term.

Understanding the challenges faced by online students, many institutions utilize an accelerated course structure where students enroll in 8-week classes within a traditional 16-week semester. The result is a full-time course load of six credits in a term without ever taking more than one class at a time. Some programs have distilled courses down further to five weeks. Other programs follow a 16-week semester as well, but do not shorten the class time, resulting in full-time students taking courses congruently.

Conversely, it is important for potential online MPA students to understand the maximum time allowed to complete a degree. Most institutions allow up to six years to finish all coursework, which includes any semester the student is not enrolled.

How much money can I earn with an accelerated online MPA degree?

An MPA degree opens the door to opportunities for a fulfilling career with an attractive salary and benefits. According to the Office of Personnel Management, the average federal government worker earns a salary of approximately \$85,000. And with more than 350 distinct careers, there are careers of all types to choose from.

Online MPA graduates often work for organizations known as non-governmental organizations, or NGOs. These organizations generally work toward social change through policy creation and analysis. The salaries vary greatly, but senior policy analysts earn well into the six-figure range, with salaries averaging \$135,000 on an annual basis. For context, the average salary of all occupations tracked by the Bureau of Labor Relations is \$39,820.

One of the great strengths of an MPA is its diversity and utility. Graduates learn useful skills needed for top positions in a wide range of industries. MPA graduates work in higher education, health care, human resources, information technology, and virtually any industry out there. That means salaries vary greatly but are generally well above the norm, given the fact MPA degrees are designed to help people fill leadership positions. When considering salary, MPA graduates should also consider high-paying regions of the country such as Washington, DC, Maryland, and Virginia.

We reviewed a total of 165 colleges and universities listed by the Center for Educational Statistics (NCES) College Navigator and reputable online sources that offered online MBA programs. To narrow our search, we considered programs with no GMAT requirement and online instruction. We further narrowed our original pool of schools by applying the following criteria: accreditation (both national or regional), institution rankings with a publication like U.S. News and World Report, and affordable graduate tuition and fees less than \$25,000 per year. We then ranked our findings according to raw affordability.

Below are the results of our top 50 most affordable best online MBA no GMAT programs.

#50 – Northeastern University Online MBA Boston, Massachusetts







With the preferred work experience, a GMAT or GRE waiver may be offered. According to U.S. News and World Report, University of Arkansas ranks #160 in best national universities.

Frequently Asked Questions What can you do with an executive MBA online degree?

Executives and managers are the brains behind the business plans, policies, and strategies of companies and organizations. While top executives usually begin their careers as business professionals, they move up the ladder with adequate experience and education.

Students enrolled in executive MBA programs gain an edge over competition with only an MBA degree. Students who complete an online EMBA program will be qualified for a range of leadership positions. Available career paths for graduates of EMBA online programs are as follows:

Advertising and marketing managers

With an EMBA, you might qualify for an advertising, marketing, or promotion manager positions. These niche managers handle the creativity behind marketing campaigns and promotions, generating buzz for business, services, and goods.

• Financial managers and executives

Financial managers are responsible for handling and overseeing the financial activities of their organizations. They also create and ensure adherence to short- and long-term budgets while handling financial and investment concerns.

Human resource managers

A human resource manager with an EMBA leads organizations on their HR efforts. They often oversee recruitment and hiring, professional development, and other human resource operations.

Top executives

Top executives or CEOs and COOs are the upper-level leaders of an organization. They oversee budget planning, finances, marketing, and supply chain, as well as other niche areas of business within the organization.

What is the job outlook for individuals with an executive MBA online degree?

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), employment in business and financial occupations is projected to grow five percent through 2029. The percentage is faster than the average for all occupations and adds over 476,000 new jobs to the industry.

Top executives should also see a favorable job outlook. In fact, BLS reports the overall employment of top executives is projected to grow four percent between 2019 and 2029.

The greatest projected growth is with general and operations managers. A growth of six percent is expected for this niche of business, which is much faster than the average for all occupations. As organizations continue to rely on operations managers to help them operate successfully, positions will open up.

Approximately 218,000 job openings for top executives are projected each year. What draws individuals to top executive jobs is the high earnings potential and prestige associated with these positions. To qualify for a top executive job, one must hold an advanced business degree, such as the online EMBA. Individuals with an advanced degree and years of managerial experience will have the best job prospects. As workers retire or transfer to different occupations or organizations, openings for top executive positions will arise.

How much money can I earn with an executive MBA online degree?

Top executives earn a considerable wage. In fact, the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) reports the median annual wage for chief executives was close to \$185,000 in May 2019. The highest ten percent of earners in chief and top executive positions made over \$208,000 annually.

With an executive MBA online degree, you may qualify for management positions. While top executive positions require substantial experience, sometimes more than ten years, operations and general management positions require less. However, operations and general managers still make six figures. In fact, BLS reports the median annual wage for general and operations managers in May

2019 was just over \$100,000. While the lowest ten percent of earners made \$45,000, the highest ten percent earned more than \$208,000.

The pay varies for top executives by industry. BLS reports the top-paying industries as follows:

Manufacturing Professional, scientific, and technical services Healthcare and social assistance Government

Earnings for the above business industries were as follows:

Top executives in manufacturing earned \$208,000 or more. Top executives in professional, scientific, and technical services earned \$208,000 or more. Top executives in healthcare and social assistance earned an average of \$166,140. Top executives in government earned \$110,230.

Are there professional associations I can join while enrolled in online executive MBA programs?

Students enrolled in online executive MBA programs are not traditional students. To be eligible for admission to an EMBA online program, you must be employed as a professional or have completed at least five years of professional business employment. As a working professional and an EMBA student, you may be eligible to join a professional association. Benefits of joining an association include gaining access to resources and a host of services. Below are three professional associations for EMBA online students.

Association of MBAs

The London-based consortium is one of the only professional association with MBA students, graduates, schools, and employers as members from all over the world. In fact, the AMBA includes 200 accredited business schools worldwide. Through this extensive network, members gain access to the AMBA career center and a large number of professional development courses.

Executive MBA Council

The EMBAC has over 330 members and acts as a global voice for the EMBA industry. Access to networking opportunities and industry events makes the EMBAC a reputable association to join.

National Association of Women MBAs

Geared toward recognition and a strong female presence in today's business world, the NAWMBA supports its members through an annual national conference. Also, throughout the year, the NAWMBA sponsors local chapter meetings and networking opportunities.

What coursework will I take while earning my online EMBA?

Courses in executive MBA online programs vary by school, but overall, curriculum adheres to the same principles of preparing business professionals for advanced careers and leadership roles. While traditional MBA programs focus on the foundations and fundamentals of business, EMBA programs teach students how to apply business practices to their current organizations.

In most online EMBA programs, students complete core coursework in areas like entrepreneurship, international business strategies, management, marketing, and team building, to name a few. Some

programs offer electives that explore niche business areas like accounting, finance, and human resources.

Also, some EMBA programs offer concentrations designed for students to tailor their degree toward areas of interest. You might find concentrations in business analytics, business venturing, executive management, finance, health administration, operations and supply chain management, or strategic selling. Students must take a certain number of classes (usually two or three) that dive deeper into an area of focus.

EMBA programs differ from traditional MBA programs with respect to course requirements and content. While MBA programs focus on fundamental concepts and business theories, EMBA programs offer study that applies to real-world framework. EMBA courses are designed to prepare the student to become an effective leader in the corporate world.
